

Gifts- Video

Hey crafty friends! Anat Kesler here. Thank you very much for joining me today in five minutes crafts. I'm going to create a gift box.

So, I have two twelve by twelve papers and were going to start by folding the first paper. You can use a folder. Corner to corner and again corner to corner, basically, having four triangles. Now, we take each corner and fold it to the center. Like this, and you can use double sided paper as well and you can use card stock. I'm just using plain paper. Open that up and now, you take each corner and fold it to the opposite fold line. This spot, here, and you do that with all four corners to the opposite fold line and as you can see, we are basically creating little squares on our paper. Okay, so now you take each corner and you're gonna fold it to the closest fold line that you have.

Now we are done with the folding and we are gonna cut. See all the squares? I'm just gonna mark this with a pencil. These are the cuts that we're gonna make. Two parallel lines and on the other side as well. From the third fold line to the first fold line. So, we're gonna cut with a knife. You can do it with scissors if you prefer and we need four cuts. Two on each side.

Okay, so now we are gonna fold. The corner inside and again inside along the fold lines that we have and we're gonna take the two sides and fold them in. We'll do the same thing on the other side. These are going to be the walls of our box. Now, what we're gonna do is, we'll bring them in, like this, and take the other two sides and fold them over, those walls. This is what closes the box. Fold them over. You don't need to use any glue. Although I like to use a little bit of tiny amount of glue in the bottom here, just strengthening the fold lines. I'm just gonna use a little bit of double-sided tape to secure this box and now the bottom part is ready.

We are gong to do the same thing. This is gonna be the top part. For the bottom part, we are going to do the same thing only we are going to cut out eighth of an inch on each side. As long as your paper is squared, you can create this box. So, the bottom part needs to be a tiny bit smaller than the top part which is the lid so it will close easily. So, take one eighth of an inch and cut it on both sides. So now I'm just gonna do the

same thing exactly the same folds as we did for the first top part. Once you do it once or twice, you're gonna get the hang of it. It's easy and fast. You can create many gift boxes this way. For whatever holiday or birthday, anniversary whatever gift you want to give. And you can customize it in size, in color and in theme. So, this is a really good way to create a box for whatever gift that you want.

So now my box is ready! There it is! And you can decide how much you want to close it or open it. If your gift is taller or smaller, you can adjust it in any way that you want.
